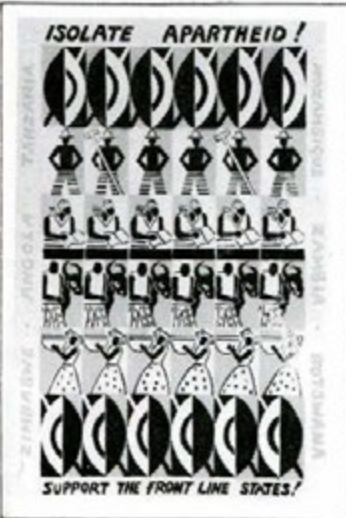
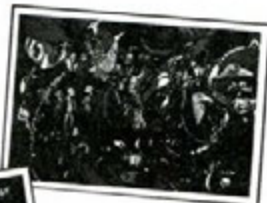

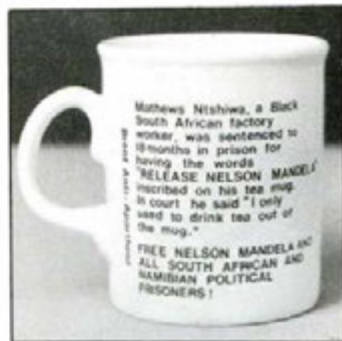

GOODS AND GIFTS FROM THE FRONT LINE STATES

The six Southern African front line states — Angola, Botswana, Mozambique, Tanzania, Zambia and Zimbabwe — form a political grouping in solidarity with the liberation movements.

They have paid a high price for their stand. The damage to their economies from South African aggression is estimated at more than £10,000 million since 1980 and apartheid's war has cost them 100,000

lives in the same period.

The Anti-Apartheid Movement campaigns in solidarity with the front line states, through publicity and information work, support for material aid initiatives such as the AFRICA Fund, and pressure on the British government. AA Enterprises aims to promote alternative trade and economic links with the front line states by selling their products.

Formed in 1912, the ANC unites South Africans from all parts of the country and all walks of life in the fight for a new, non-racial South Africa based on the principles of democracy, equality and human dignity.

In 1959, the then president of the ANC Chief Albert Luthuli called for an

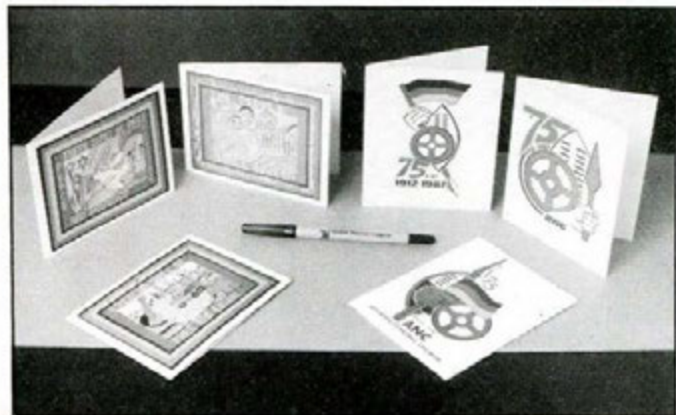

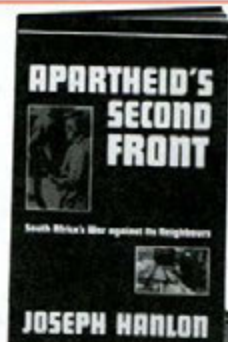
