For the first time there are encouraging signs of change in South Africa: some political prisoners have been released, some rallies have been allowed, Namibia is moving towards independence.

This has happened because of both mass opposition inside South Africa and pressure from outside. The British government acknowledged this by endorsing the Kuala Lumpur Statement.

It also acknowledged that the pillars of apartheid remain. If apartheid is to be abolished, pressure must be maintained on the South African government.
