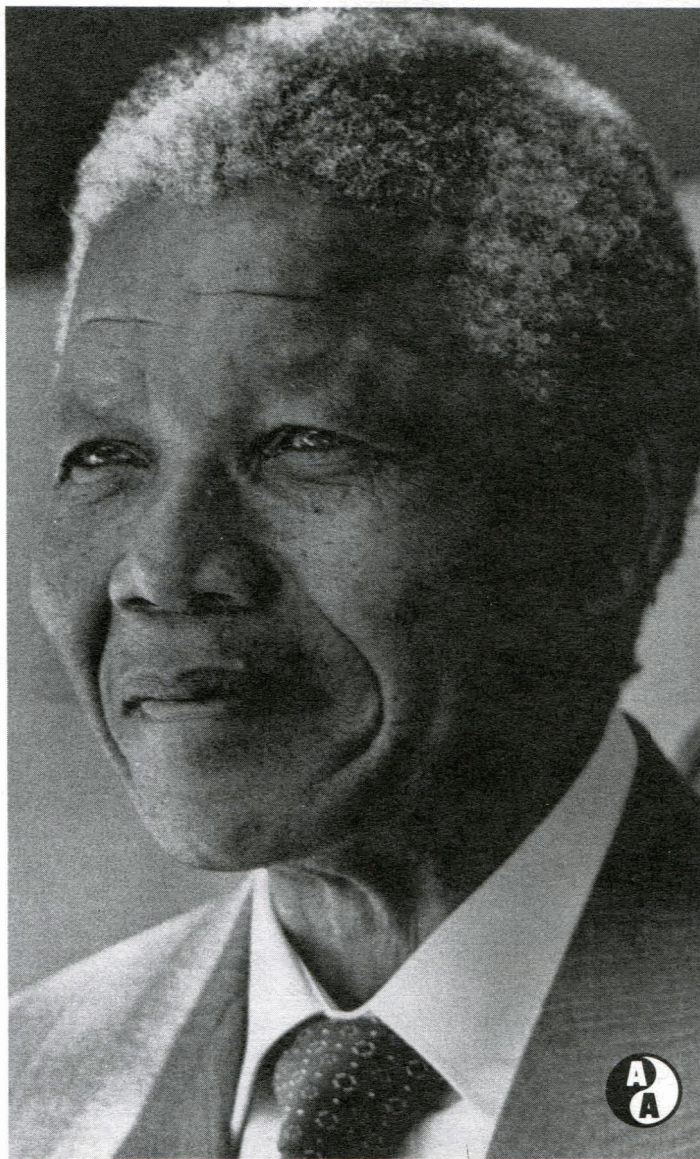

Nelson Mandela, in a message to the people of Britain said,

“...Take whatever action you can to isolate apartheid and impose peoples' sanctions. Don't buy the produce of apartheid”.

Don't buy South African goods. South Africa is still not free from racial tyranny which denies basic human rights to the majority black population. The changes in South Africa - some positive such as the release of Nelson Mandela, and the unbanning of the African National Congress - do not mean the end of apartheid. The pillars of apartheid remain in place.

The British government's wish to remove sanctions relaxes pressure at a time when it should be increased to force the white minority South African regime to completely dismantle apartheid. Now is the wrong time to remove sanctions just as they begin to show signs of success.

You can help turn Mandela's vision of a new, democratic, non-racial, united South Africa into a reality. Peoples' sanctions are the building blocks of sanctions imposed by governments. Show you disagree with Mrs Thatcher's policy by refusing to buy the products of apartheid.
