

THE UNHOLY ALLIANCE

- IN KATANGA WELENSKY AND EUROPEAN VESTED INTERESTS ARE CONSPIRING TO PREVENT THE RE-UNIFICATION OF THE CONGO.
- SOUTH AFRICA RECENTLY SIGNED A DEFENCE PACT WITH MOZAMBIQUE
- SOUTHERN RHODESIA DEFENCE FORCES HAVE BEEN TRAINING IN SOUTH AFRICA

The scandal of British policy in Katanga has at last drawn the world's attention to what can only be described as the conspiracy in Southern Africa to obstruct African freedom. All the world, and particularly the British public, are still very little aware of the details of the interlocking interests now working in this area.

This Conference is called to draw attention to our responsibilities in Southern Africa and our failure to face up to them. With the exception of Algeria, this is the scene of the last head-on clash between African nationalism and white-minority rule. The strength of African nationalism is growing rapidly and white rule is retaliating with increasing force. If we take strong and united action in Britain we can do much to prevent this crisis from resulting in violence and brutality.

HOWEVER, BRITAIN IS NOT AT PRESENT PLAYING THIS IMPORTANT PART. ON THE CONTRARY, OUR GOVERNMENT IS ALLYING ITSELF WITH THE FORCES OF DARKNESS WHICH ARE SO DESPERATELY RESISTING FREEDOM AND DEMOCRACY FOR THE AFRICAN MAJORITY. THE FACTS ABOUT THIS COLLABORATION ARE VERY LITTLE KNOWN IN BRITAIN, BUT, THROUGH HER INVOLVEMENT IN NATO. HER RESPONSIBILITIES IN CENTRAL AFRICA AND THE HIGH COMMISSION TERRITORIES AND HER £1,000 MILLION INVESTED IN SOUTH AFRICA BRITAIN IS BANG IN THE MIDDLE OF THE "UNHOLY ALLIANCE."

For the sake of our future friendly relations with the millions of people in this area we must see to it that our Government changes its policies, and (both in the territories for which it has direct responsibility as well as in others) it uses its influence and power to make the transition to freedom, racial harmony and democracy in southern Africa as smooth as possible. All people of goodwill in Britain, of whatever party, religion or viewpoint, who understand that it is the denial of freedom which breeds violence, must unite to achieve this change in British policy in the area. This is the purpose behind our conference — to work out the mechanics of a united campaign.
