The Portuguese were the first Europeans to establish colonies in Southern Africa. Today they are fighting for the survival of their racist and colonialist empire.

In South Africa a newer colonialism has been established. A white power state in which the black majority are denied even the most elementary rights and are treated as foreigners in their own country. Apartheid rule extends to cover Namibia (South West Africa), occupied in defiance of the wishes of the Namibian people and of international law.

Rhodesia, ruled by a white minority which uses terrorist tactics against the black majority in an effort to maintain its exploitative role, is linked with South Africa and Portugal and is assisted by them to maintain power.

This unholy white alliance calls on and receives the support of reactionary forces throughout the world.

In the name of Western Democracy and Liberty - Freedom is denied to the people they seek to rule.

In the name of Self-determination - Destinies are imposed on millions of people.

Their statesmen arrange secret agreements.

Their soldiers conduct joint military operations.

Their security forces share information and jointly plan their strategy.

Resistance to white minority rule in Southern Africa has grown:

In Mozambique, Angola and Guine Bissau vast areas of land have been liberated from Portuguese control and the foundations of a new and free society have been laid.

In Namibia and Zimbabwe (Rhodesia) the liberation struggle is gaining wide support. Advances are being made.

In South Africa, striking workers, protesting students, black organisations and churches are confronting the apartheid monster in growing numbers.

It is only a matter of time before armed struggle takes hold in every corner of Southern Africa - destroying the racist and colonialist alliance between Caetano, Vorster and Smith.

Britain's long history of support for colonialism and minority race rule in Southern Africa is again emphasised with the celebrations to mark the 600th anniversary of the Anglo-Portuguese Alliance.

Marcello Caetano, Prime Minister of Portugal, arrives tomorrow for a four-day official visit.
