SOUTH AFRICAN BUREAU OF STATE SECURITY

We are writing to express our concern at the recent press revelations concerning the alleged activities of agents of the South African Bureau of State Security in the United Kingdom, and to raise a number of specific points relating to Her Majesty's Government's policy.

You will be aware that on numerous occasions in the past the Anti-Apartheid Movement has found it necessary to draw attention to the activities of South African intelligence agents in the United Kingdom, both prior to and since the formation of the Bureau of State Security. However, these activities continue and we believe that further action is required by Her Majesty's Government.

We understand that your Government is aware of the presence of BOSS and other South African agents in the United Kingdom. Indeed, according to press reports, liaison still takes place between the Special Branch and BOSS agents.

We would therefore request that you give urgent consideration to:

- 1) establishing an enquiry into South African intelligence activity within the United Kingdom;
- 2) the immediate deportation of all known BOSS agents;
- 3) the termination of all liaison between British and South African intelligence.

We look forward to hearing from you on these points.
