Support the fight against apartheid


The Menace of Apartheid threatens not only to unleash a bloody Civil War in South Africa; it also threatens to engulf the whole Southern African Region.

In **Namibia**, one in ten of the population has gone into exile from the illegal South African occupation. 110,000 troops brutally crush all resistance.

In **Angola**, invaded shortly after independence in 1975, the people have to defend their country against South African military incursions, South African-backed UNITA terrorists and South African-paid saboteurs.

In **Mozambique**, the battle against starvation and disease is hampered by South African backing for the MNR - terrorists who murder farmers, teachers and nurses and help South Africa's destabilisation of the country.

All of the Front-line States are threatened by South Africa's economic stranglehold and repeated acts of military aggression.



In **South Africa** the reign of terror is maintained under a veil of secrecy. Over the past three years the oppressed people have made great sacrifices in their bid to end apartheid. They have worked, struggled, fought and died against tremendous odds. Their victory will come.


