This picket has been held every Friday since August 1985. supported by dozens of organisations taking turns each week to show their abhorrence of apartheid.

The function of the Consulate is to represent the South African regime and to promote its interests throughout Scotland. As well as open propaganda work, it is the centre of a web of front organisations promoting a "positive" view of the appalling events in South Africa.

The Anti-Apartheid Movement calls for the closure of this outpost of apartheid, representing a regime which:

- Divides people at birth according to race and then denies by law the most basic human rights to the black majority:
- Denies black South Africans any share in electing the government which controls their lives;
- Uproots whole black communities whose land has been declared "white". Four million people have been moved.
- Enforces by law the break-up of millions of black families through the migrant labour system.
- Shoots, detains and tortures those protesting for equal rights, including children under twelve years old;
- Illegally occupies Namibia, and mounts military attacks on all the neighbouring states.
