

## **Boycott Apartheid Gold!**

Mandela is free, but apartheid continues and so must the struggle against it. Mandela's message is that sanctions must stay in place to help the struggle for a free South Africa - united, non-racial and democratic.

Sanctions imposed by people and by governments have worked and they are still needed. You can help bring freedom to South Africa by refusing to buy South African gold and other apartheid goods. South African gold, mainly used for jewellery, helps pay for apartheid. By switching to other suppliers, jewellers will be adding to the pressure on de Klerk to negotiate a genuine end to apartheid.

## You can help:

- Don't buy apartheid gold, or other South African goods.
- · Ask jewellers to switch to non-South African gold.
- · Join the Anti-Apartheid Movement
