

SAVIMBI GO HOME

TODAY JONAS SAVIMBI, AN ARCH ENEMY OF AFRICAN FREEDOM AND KEY PUPPET OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN APARTHEID REGIME, IS SPEAKING TO A SECRET MEETING AT THE INSTITUTE FOR STRATEGIC STUDIES.

Savimbi is in London in a move calculated to legitimise South Africa's latest aggression against Angola. Its army has attempted to occupy two whole provinces of that country, using 8 battalions of her army, helicopters and three jet squadrons. This invasion was deliberately launched to undermine international efforts to hold United Nations supervised elections in Namibia, over which it maintains its illegal rule.

Now Jonas Savimbi, who makes no secret of his backing from South Africa, is in Britain on a private visit at the invitation of Lord Chalfont, in a clear bid to win support from the enemies of African freedom in Britain.

Following the defeat of the South African invasion of Angola in 1976 Savimbi's UNITA has been virtually an arm of the South African army, attempting to de-stabilise the south of Angola, in an attempt to force the Angolan government to abandon its support for the liberation struggle in Southern Africa.

We believe that his visit - following hard on the heels of the invasion and South African efforts to block the Namibia talks by saying that UNITA must be included - is part of a further manouvre to win new friends for Pretoria.
