

Namibia Emergency Campaign 2nd Mobilising Conference

The NEC is continuing to build maximum support for Namibia's liberation movement, SWAPO, now the majority party in the Constituent Assembly preparing for independence. We must ensure not only that there is a full transfer of power to the Namibian people, but also that the international community supports the newly-independent country and prevents possible South African destabilisation.

- Will South Africa seek to undermine the work of the elected Constituent Assembly through military or other means?
- Will the British government and others offer firm support for the UN in its continuing role during this period?
- Will the UN force remain intact or will there be further attempts to reduce its strength and open the way for further problems?
- How do we continue to build maximum support for SWAPO and the people of Namibia?
- How do we tackle the longer term issues: aid to post-independence Namibia; attempts by South Africa to destabilise newly independent Namibia; the reintegration of Walvis Bay and the offshore islands?

The conference will address these issues and provide activists with an opportunity to receive a full briefing on the election results, their implications, the tasks ahead for SWAPO and the Namibian people, and also for solidarity work here in Britain.
